Rick Havens of 314 Maple Avenue has a complaint concerning the property at 310 Maple Avenue. The property is not being maintained year round. The sidewalks are never

shoveled when it snows, the grass is not being cut, trees and bushes are not being trimmed. The shed has broken windows, he feels this is dangerous. The borough planted trees. The trees need cut back and shaped. Residents cannot keep garbage cans in the alley 24/7. The garbage men are responsible for half of the garbage in the alley.
