

**Marysville Borough Sewer Committee**

**MINUTES**

1. Resolution No. 214 Losch Framing and Fine Art

Committee agreed that it would be appropriate to bill Losch Framing and Fine Art at a commercial 1 rate which would be \$83.00 for refuse per quarter and \$198.78 for sewer per quarter. The committee also reviewed the resolution and directed Brian to create new price structure classifications for the various categories.

2. Consumption based billing

Committee decided to remain with the current flat rate billing system.

3. Cards / Folding Machine

Committee will make a recommendation to borough council to spend up to \$1,500 to purchase a folding machine and have AMS configure the system for paper billing rather than the post cards currently being used (consolidated items 4 and 5 on the agenda).

4. Monthly billing

Committee determined to continue with the quarterly billing system except for residents who request to pay monthly.

5. Sewer Line Televising

The committee will recommend spending up to \$3,000 to have JetVac televise the sewer lines in the downtown area. Ron Brown indicated that it is needed since the sewer lines are not safe to physically inspect due to the age of the system.

6. Rockville Estates Status Meeting (see attached)

Nothing to comment on.

7. Automatic debit for monthly payments

Committee agreed that it would be too burdensome to set up automatic debits for all residential accounts. The committee agreed that it can be implemented for

delinquent accounts that can't afford to pay the entire balance or 50% of the balance.
