**Minutes**

1. Refuse RFP

The committee opened the Refuse / Recycling Bids at approximately 8:15am and read them aloud. Brian informed the bidders that the packets will be available for review at the July 14<sup>th</sup> borough council meeting when a bid is awarded. The bids for article VII were as follows:

Interstate Waste Services:	\$213,746.08
York Waste Disposal:	\$230,397.00
Penn Waste:	\$279,897.00
Waste Management Inc:	\$362,400.00

2. Trout Run

Brian informed the committee that Dan Altland has been in contact with Chadagas's attorney to determine if they would be agreeable to condensing the lot width of the first 2 units. Dr. Chadagas then asked if the borough would agree to reduce the 20' minimum lot width to 11' for the whole park. Dan emailed his attorney and indicated that we would not be agreeable to that since 11' between all units would pose a serious fire threat to the whole park. We have not heard back from the attorney yet.

3. Rockville Estates Grinder Pumps – Ordinance

Ron Brown provided a sample grinder pump resolution that the borough should consider in light of Rockville Estates having grinder pumps for a small portion of the development.

4. Rose Andrae – 103 Valley Street Extension

Brian informed the committee that he stopped at Rose Andrae's house and informed the tenant in the lower unit that she is not allowed to reside in the unit since it is a commercial establishment only permitted on the lower unit.
