1. Bittings Alley Paving RFP

The bids for Bitting's Alley were received and opened at 8:30am.

2. Stop sign at Maple Street & Spruce Street

Brian informed the committee that a stop sign was requested at the above noted intersection. The committee agreed that the intersection can use two additional stop signs and also noted that there are other areas in the borough to consider. Brian will identify the areas and put the issue on the August council agenda.

3. 600 Myrtle Avenue – Drainage Issues

Brian informed the committee that he received complaints from the property owner about the gathering of water in the front of her residence. The committee indicated that it is the property owner's responsibility to maintain the curbing and sidewalk.

4. Zoning Officer for overall plan review for Rockville Estates.

Brian informed the committee that he will use Pennoni for the overall plan review and that he will do the zoning permits thereafter for the individual phases and lots.

5. Valley Street Curbing

Brian informed the committee that storm water runoff is coming off state Route 850 and traveling down the unopened street and leaving debris on Front Street. Brian is going to contact Scott Lehman to see if the borough can put curbing on 850 to correct the problem.

6. Valley Street Extension Curb

Brian informed the committee John Staz would like us to repaint the curb on the south side of Valley Street Extension. Brian informed the committee that per the

ordinance there is no loading or unloading or no parking allowed. Brian is going to check with Scott Lehman to determine if there are any issues with the ROW off of a state road.
