

**Marysville Borough Sewer Committee**

**Minutes**

1. Wesley United Methodist Detention Basin

Brian informed the committee that Ron Brown looked at the detention pond at the church and compared it to the construction documents. Ron indicated that the outfall inlet was not constructed properly and that the 6" hole needs to be 2 feet lowered to allow the basin to drain. Once the hole is lowered, it will allow the basin to work properly and then vegetation can become established. Brian will call Pastor Parker and have him contact a contractor to drill additional holes in the inlet.

2. Refuse Rates

As a result of the most recent trash bid, the committee determined that the refuse rates for the commercial customers having containers will be \$75 higher than the current rate per quarter. The commercial customers not having containers will be \$50 higher than the residential rate. Home occupations will be \$25 higher than the residential rate per quarter. Brian will calculate the remaining residential rate. The resolution will be on the September council agenda.

3. Operator's Report

Brian informed the committee that he would like to see \$25,000 allocated to the 2009 Sewer Fund Budget for miscellaneous repairs at the sewer plant. Brian would like to see this amount allocated each year for capital improvements and the committee agreed to recommend budgeting an amount each year.
