1. Bittings Alley Paving Project

Project was completed and the final price was \$65,000 rather than \$81,500 since the sub-base was in good condition and no aggregate was needed. The project was bid on a per ton basis. In addition, the alley was narrower than the 20 foot estimate.

Our liquid fuel fund is now \$63,000 + \$50,000+/- in 2009. We should begin to consider what street we would like to pave in 2009 (if any) with a maximum price of \$100,000. I would like a project to be bid in the Spring if possible.

The committee would like to look into paving from the intersection of Caroline Drive to the mobile home park on Kings Highway.

2. Perry County Hazard Mitigation Plan Resolution

The attached resolution and executive summary is for the adoption of a hazard mitigation plan that was endorsed by the commissioners and surrounding counties. If the resolution is desired, we will add it to the council agenda for adoption.

The committee recommended the resolution be put on the council agenda under new business.

3. Designated Snow Emergency Routes

Would the borough consider amending the ordinance to reflect Cameron Street as a designated snow emergency route per the Fire Company's request.
