Codes Enforcement with East Pennsboro Township - Tabled

Lance Barthel requested East Pennsboro Township attend the next work session to discuss the code enforcement to the council as a whole, so everyone is getting the correct information. Council agreed to have them attend the next work session. Scott Weaver will contact East Pennsboro Township to have them attend the work session.

Dead Ash Tree's Through Out Borough

Scott reported throughout the borough there are 42 dead ash trees and one (1) located on borough property. Scott Weaver reported he sent out 42 letters to have the trees removed especially ones leaning toward houses or roads. This is a public safety issue for borough residence.

Curbing Repair/Replacement of for Sewer Separation and Paving

Scott Weaver said he sent out letters to the residents regarding the curbing. He said he has received a few phone calls.

Brian Webster said the Fire Company will be cooking the chicken for the Marysville Moose Lodge #107 on September 23, 2017 for them to sell.
