

# Marysville Borough Bulk Collection Guidelines



Each residence may place (1) ONE bulk item per week at the curb for pickup on trash day. Bulk items are too large or bulky to be removed by one person. No scheduling is needed prior to removal.

White goods or appliances containing FREON (air conditioner, refrigerator, freezer, dehumidifier) must have FREON gas removed professionally and sticker affixed to unit, prior to collection day.

## Acceptable Bulk/Brush Items

- Furniture -Sofa, chair, table, desk, dresser, headboard, bed frame, cabinet.
- Outdoor grill (MUST remove tanks)
- Lawn mower (Push-type only, Remove fluids)
- Mattress (Wrap and seal in plastic)
- Box spring (Wrap and seal in plastic)
- Door or window (Place 'X' of tape over glass)
- Washer
- Clothes Dryer
- Kitchen stove
- Microwave
- Humidifier
- Hot water heater (MUST be drained)
- Kitchen / bathroom sink or toilet
- Air conditioner-window size (Must have Freon Free sticker)
- Dehumidifiers (Must have Freon Free sticker)
- Freezers (Must have Freon Free sticker)
- Refrigerators (Must have Freon Free sticker)
- Bookcase or shelving unit
- Fixtures
- Small portable heater (NO fluids or fuels)
- Carpet roll - Not to exceed 4 feet in length.
- Lawn / Patio furniture

## Non- Acceptable Items

- NO Televisions, computers, printers or monitors
- NO Riding mowers
- NO Automotive parts or Batteries
- NO Car or Truck tires
- NO Cast iron items
- NO Propane tanks or pressurized tanks
- NO Pianos or Organs
- NO Yard Debris - branches, stumps, logs
- NO Landscape materials (railroad ties, pavers, pressure treated lumber)
- NO Construction Debris - block, brick, lumber, pavers, rock or soil
- NO Fluid containers of any type
- NO Drums - Steel or plastic
- NO Paints, Solvents or Cleaners

**Please note:** WM can no longer dispose of CFC refrigerant containing items (i.e., refrigerators, freezers, etc.) without certification that the Freon has been properly removed and recycled, pursuant to current Federal law.

**Remember.** If an item is still in good, working condition, consider donating it to a local organization for reuse or resale. (i.e. Goodwill Industries or Habitat for Humanity ReStore.) Some offer free pickup of your item.
