# Grass, Weeds and Other Vegetation

No person, owning or occupying any property within the Borough of Marysville, shall permit any grass or weeds or any vegetation whatsoever, not edible or planted for some useful or ornamental purpose, to grow or remain upon such premises to exceed a height of 6 inches.

# **Unregistered/Unlicensed Vehicles**

No unregistered or unlicensed motor vehicle shall be permitted on private property in the Borough for a period in excess of 30 days unless it is enclosed in a permanent structure.

# **Swimming Pools**

Any resident with an above ground (any size) or in ground swimming pool MUST apply for a zoning permit prior to installing the pool. There are set backs that have to be met in order to have the pool. A pool cannot be closer than eight (8) feet from your property lines and ten feet from a residence.

# **Police News**



Residents are reminded Street Sweeping takes place every month on the 3rd Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 8:00am-5:00pm. Please take notice to the posted signs to avoid parking tickets. If you receive a parking ticket, please pay it promptly. Failure to pay a \$15.00 parking ticket will result in a Traffic Citation being issued.

Warmer temperatures mean an increase in outdoor activity of children in the Borough. Parents, please help ensure your children's safety by making them wear helmets when riding bicycles and scooters. PA laws require all children under the age of 12 to wear an approved helmet when riding a bicycle or scooter. Parents are also reminded Marysville Borough has a Curfew Ordinance. Curfew for minors under age 14 years is 10:00pm, for minors between age 14 and 18 years, curfew is 11:00pm. Please be aware that anyone on a bicycle or scooter has the duties to obey stop signs and other traffic control devices as someone operating a motor vehicle.





Warmer weather also means an increase of motorcycles on Pennsylvania roadways. Please "Watch For Motorcycles". I'd like to also remind all drivers, it is illegal to text and drive in Pennsylvania. This includes texting while at red lights and stop signs. Distracted driving has become the #1 contributing factor of all Motor Vehicle Accidents in the United States. No text is worth dying for or worse yet killing someone.

Residents are reminded it is unlawful to let cats and dogs run at large. ALL cats and dogs must be leashed or under direct physical control at all times. Owners are also responsible for picking up and properly disposing of their pet's waste. For those using the Memorial Walking Path at the Marysville Lions Club, plastic bags and disposal containers are provided for pet waste.



Marysville Police Department has a Medication Drop Box located inside the Borough Office. Any unwanted or unused medication in pill or tablet form can be dropped in the drop box. No liquid medications can be accepted. No information is required from persons dropping off medication. The Borough office is open Monday-Friday from 7am-3pm. Two other drop boxes are located in the Perry County Courthouse in New Bloomfield and Take it to **THE BOX** Pennsylvania State Police Barracks in Newport.

Marysville PD is still offering a Special Needs Resident Registry Program for our residents. The program is for residents with any special needs to include but not limited to Dementia, Alzheimer's, Autism, physical limitations, and electricity dependent (example: oxygen machine). Residents with such needs can complete a Special Needs Resident Data Registration Form. The form includes a current photo, name, address, physical attributes, medical summary, emergency contacts, and other information important to aid officers and other first responders during an emergency situation. Emergency situations could include medical emergency, missing person/wandering, natural disaster, power outage or other critical incident. # **Garbage & Recyclable**

Garbage and Recyclable **CAN NOT** be put out before 5:00pm on the day before pickup and needs to be out by 5:00am on the day of pick up.

Please make sure all trash is put in bags and tied. NO loose trash allowed.

**<u>DO NOT</u>** put trash in the green recycle cans. The green cans are ONLY for recyclables. If there is garbage in the green cans it will not be picked up.

Residents are allowed four bags of trash and one large item a week.

<u>Green Recycle Cans:</u> There will be an \$18.00 charge for recycle cans.

# **Large Item Pick-Up**

If you have a large item you can place it out with your trash. No need to call Waste Management for the pickup. Large items include box spring, mattress, furniture, appliances, etc.

"White goods containing FREON (air conditioner, refrigerator, freezer, dehumidifier, etc.) must have Freon professionally removed prior to collection".

# Notice to Pet Owners

With spring and summer approaching we would like to remind pet owners the law requires pets to be kept on a leash and pet waste be cleaned up and disposed of properly.



In the past, it has been visibly noticed that pet owners did not adhere to the above mentioned law at the Marysville Borough and Marysville Lions Park playground area.

For your convenience the Marysville Borough and Lions Club purchased pet waste eliminator stands and bags that have been placed throughout the park for you to utilize.

The Marysville Borough and Marysville Lions Club reserves the right to close the park to all pets with the exception of guide/service pets if this practice continues.

# **Marysville Borough Pool Rules**

- All persons who enter the pool do so at their own risk. We are not responsible for any accident, injury, theft or damage to personal property.
- Smoking and alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
- Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a person 16 or older who will accept responsibility for the safety and conduct of the child. Individuals found irresponsible will be asked to leave the pool.
- No running, pushing, spitting, rough housing, profanity, or lewd behavior permitted.
- No glass containers, metal or bulky items are permitted in the pool area.
- Adult swims: adults may take their children 6 and younger, into the shallow end. The deep end of the pool is for adults 18 years and older. The adult swims are at the discretion of the lifeguards.
- Lifeguards may refuse a swimmer admission to any pool area if the swimmer does not exhibit sufficient skill to insure his/her safety.
- In case of an accident, report it immediately to a lifeguard or the Pool Manager.
- Management reserves the right to refuse admission to anyone with skin abrasions, colds, coughs, inflamed eyes, athlete's feet, infectious disorders, communicable diseases, or persons wearing band-aids.
- The cost of any property damage shall be charged to the responsible member, including damage caused by the guest of the member.
- Any member allowing another person to use his/her pool pass may result in suspension of pool privileges.
- Thongs are prohibited.
- All swimmers must wear a bathing suit or bathing trunks.
- Showers are required before swimming.

# WADING/BABY POOL

- The wading/baby pool is not under the immediate supervision of a lifeguard. Parents and/or Guardians are reminded that children in the wading/baby pool are *THEIR* responsibility.
- Children in diapers are required to wear swim diapers.
- The wading/baby pool is for children under the age of 6.

# **SLIDES**

- No horseplay, pushing, running or cutting in line.
- You must slide and enter the pool feet first.
- Clear the landing area or exit the pool by the ladder.
- One slider at a time—no stopping.

# **DIVING BOARD**

- If you are using the diving board for the first time you may be asked to show a lifeguard you can swim a section of the pool.
- Only one person at a time is allowed on the board; only bounce is permitted.
- You may NOT enter the water backwards or dive to the side.
- After diving please exit the area immediately.
- Be courteous and patient when there are smaller children on the diving board and in the water below.

Any activities or items not covered in the above rules will be judged by the Pool Manager/Lifeguards.

The Pool Manager and/or any other personnel are the absolute authority and may discipline, suspend or dismiss any pool member or guest who violates pool rules. Serious or successive violations may be sufficient cause for cancellation of membership with no refund.

**PARENTS:** Instruct your children and urge them to read and observe all rules and to obey the Pool Manager, lifeguards and other employees.


