Please utilize your off-street parking when it starts to snow. This will allow the plows to push the snow to the curb.

Do not place snow from sidewalks or private property onto the street. Snow removed to create parking is a violation of the

ordinance for anyone to throw, discharge or place snow from the sidewalk or private property onto the borough streets. Snow which is removed from the street to provide space for parked cars must be deposited adjacent to curbing and not placed on the road on which traffic travels.

Snow and ice must be removed from all sidewalks within 24 hours after the snowfall.

In order to simplify the movement of traffic and to combat the hazards of snow and ice on the snow emergency routes named in §15-703 of this Part, the Mayor, in his/her discretion, may declare a snow and ice emergency. Information on the existence of a snow emergency shall be given by the Borough of Marysville through radio, newspaper or other available media, and information on the termination of the emergency may be given by use of the same media.

After any snow emergency due to accumulation of ice or two (2) or more inches of snow, it shall be unlawful, at any time during the continuance of the emergency, for any person:

To park a motor vehicle or to allow that vehicle to remain parked anywhere on any snow emergency route designated in §15-703 of this Part; or,

To drive any motor vehicle on any such snow emergency route, unless that vehicle is equipped with snow tires or chains or all season tires.

Plow trucks will make every effort to push snow back to the curb line to maintain travel lanes. It would help the plow trucks a great deal if you would utilize your off street parking spaces. If you see the plow trucks go past a couple times and only open the lanes for the traffic don't worry the trucks will be back to push the snow to the curb line. In order for the



snow to be pushed against the curb line, your car will need to be moved to off street if available.

At times mailboxes are hit while plowing. The borough will repair your mailbox if it's hit by one of the borough plow trucks. The borough will not pay for repairs if your mailbox is hit with snow or ice. We will try to make every effort for this not to happen; however accidents can happen especially with large snow storms.



Garbage and Recyclable **CAN NOT** be put out before 5:00pm on the day before pickup and needs to be out by 5:00am on the day of pick up.

Please make sure all trash is put in bags and tied. NO loose trash allowed.

<u>DO NOT</u> put trash in the green recycle cans. The green cans are ONLY for recyclables. If there is garbage in the green cans it will not be picked up.

Residents are allowed four bags of trash and one large item a week.

<u>Green Recycle Cans:</u> There will be an \$18.00 charge for recycle cans.

Large Item Pick-Up

If you have a large item you can place it out with your trash. No need to call Waste Management for the pickup. Large items include box spring, mattress, furniture, appliances, etc.

"White goods containing FREON (air conditioner, refrigerator, freezer, dehumidifier, etc.) must have Freon professionally removed prior to collection".

Marysville-Rye Historical Society

The Glenvale Mill had a long and successful presence in Rye Township. The original mill was built by Nicholas Wolf and John Bowman in 1798. It continued to operate until 1880 when it was destroyed by fire. The owners at the time, E. Neyhart and Son, immediately rebuilt the frame structure and soon sold the mill to Alexander Hartman. Under Hartman's ownership, it was converted from a grist mill (using millstones to grind the grain) to a roller mill (where water and grooved steel rollers processed grain). This was a very expensive procedure, but was necessary in order to meet the demands for higher quality flour. This new process also allowed Hartman to increase the mill's capacity to 50 barrels of processed flour a day.

In 1890, Hartman sold the business to Daniel Cowan. Cowan ran it for seven years before selling out to Henry Fisher. Upon Fisher's death, the mill was then sold to his brother-in-law Philip Heishley (spelled Heisley today). Heishley operated it from 1912 until it closed on 1931. Margaret Fry purchased the property in 1931. It was later acquired by Erskin Keene, who had the mill torn down in 1943 or 1944.






