
Sewer Assistance

Police News



The Marysville Borough Police Department wishes our residents a happy and safe Holiday Season. Winter is here and we'd like to remind residents that street sweeping will continue on the scheduled street sweeping days if the weather allows. In the event of significant snow fall, residents need to obey posted Snow Emergency Routes to avoid having their vehicle towed. Borough Ordinance also requires sidewalks to be shoveled within 24hrs of the snow fall ending and prohibits snow being shoveled onto any roadway. If a fire hydrant is located on your property, please help by clearing snow away from the hydrants. In the event of large snowfalls, please use caution navigating borough streets and watch for pedestrians and children.

During the October Borough Council meeting, council offered a full-time patrolman position to Officer Jared Charles, which he accepted. Officer Charles was previously employed as a deputy sheriff for 8 years in Perry County and currently works part-time for Mifflin Borough Police. Before starting a career in civilian law enforcement, Charles served as a Military Police Officer In the United States Marine Corp. Charles currently resides in Juniata County with his wife and their children. If you see Officer Charles on patrol, please welcome him to our community. Trends:

During winter months we historically see an influx in Domestic Assaults. More often than not, these Domestic disputes are fueled by alcohol and financial stress. This is the time of year when historically we see an increase in unlocked vehicles, garages and sheds being entered and items stolen. Please be vigilant and keep your vehicles and outbuildings secured at all times, do not make yourself an easy target for criminals.

Technology is making Identity Theft and Fraud cases more and more common and frequent. Please take the appropriate measures to safe guard your personal information. Do not give any personal information out over the phone. No government agency, including the IRS will call or solicit information over the phone. No law enforcement agency will call and inform you there is a warrant issued for your arrest and demand money. Please monitor your credit and bank statement for fraudulent activity and report any Incidents of Fraud or Theft to our Department.

Services:

Marysville Police Department has a Medication Drop Box. Any unwanted or unused medication in pill or tablet form can be dropped in the drop box located in the Marysville Borough Office. No liquid medications accepted. No Information is required from persons dropping off medication. The Borough office is open Monday-Friday from 7am-4pm. The other two drop boxes are located in the Perry County Courthouse in New Bloomfield and Pennsylvania State Police Barracks in Newport.

Marysville PD is offering our community a Special Needs Resident Registry. This program is for any Marysville Borough resident. The program is for residents with any special needs to include, but not limited to, Dementia, Alzheimer's, Autism, physical limitations, and electricity dependent (example: oxygen machine). Residents with such needs can complete a Special Needs Resident Data Registration Form. The form includes a current photo, name, address, physical attributes, medical summary, emergency contacts, and other information important to aid officers and other first responders during an emergency situation. Emergency situations could include medical emergency, missing person/wandering, natural disaster, power outage or other critical incident. 
