During winter months, please utilize your off-street parking when it starts to snow. This will allow the plows to push the snow to the curb.

Do not place snow from sidewalks or private property onto the street. Snow re-



moved to create parking is a violation of Borough ordinance; for anyone to throw, discharge or place snow from the sidewalk or private property onto the borough streets. Snow which is removed from the street to provide space for parked cars must be deposited adjacent to curbing and not placed on the road on which traffic travels.

Snow and ice must be removed from all sidewalks within 24 hours after the snow-fall.

In order to simplify the movement of traffic and to combat the hazards of snow and ice on the snow emergency routes named in §15-703 of this Part, the Mayor, in his/her discretion, may declare a snow and ice emergency. Information on the existence of a snow emergency shall be given by the Borough of Marysville through radio, newspaper or other available media, and information on the termination of the emergency may be given by use of the same media.

After any snow emergency due to accumulation of ice or two (2) or more inches of snow, it shall be unlawful, at any time during the continuance of the emergency, for any person:

To park a motor vehicle or to allow that vehicle to remain parked anywhere on any snow emergency route designated in §15-703 of this Part; or,

To drive any motor vehicle on any such snow emergency route, unless that vehicle is equipped with snow tires or chains or all season tires.

Plow trucks will make every effort to push snow back to the curb line to maintain travel lanes. It would help the plow trucks a great deal if you would utilize your off street parking spaces. If you see the plow trucks go past a

couple times and only open the lanes for the traffic don't worry the trucks will be back to push the snow to the curb line. In order for the snow to be pushed against the curb line, your car will need to be moved to off street if available.



At times mailboxes are hit while plowing. The borough will repair your mailbox if it's hit by one of the borough plow trucks. The borough will not pay for repairs if your mailbox is hit with snow or ice. We will try to make every effort for this not to happen; however accidents can happen especially with large snow storms.

MS4 in Marysville



Recently, Marysville Borough Council created an MS4 Commission. The Commission is tasked with overseeing the various MS4 projects that will be implemented throughout the Borough as well as coming up with ways to potentially fund the projects. As you may recall from the 4th quarter issue of the Borough Newsletter, MS4 is a system of stormwater conveyances and structures owned or operated by a public agency that does not connect to the sanitary sewer system and does not lead to a wastewater treatment plant. It discharges untreated water into local drainageways, streams, and rivers. In Pennsylvania, the MS4 program is implemented by the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP). DEP fulfills this role to comply with federal mandates under the Clean Water Act. The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is the federal agency charged with managing the Clean Water Act. The Borough of Marysville has a permit through the PA DEP and is required to take steps to reduce the discharge of pollutants into natural waterways. In 2017, the Borough put together a Pollutant Reduction Plan documenting the steps to be taken to reduce pollutants in the Borough through various projects. While some of the projects have been completed, the Borough is currently in the process of reviewing how to fund the remaining MS4 projects in the PRP that need to be completed to meet the unfunded mandates from the State and Federal government. The Borough hosts MS4 Commission meetings on the first Monday of each month at 5 pm at the Borough Building, and seeks public input on ways to fund the MS4 projects as well as continuing to educate the pubic on MS4 and its impact on the Borough and each resident. If you are interested in serving on the MS4 Commission, please complete an application, available on the Borough website.



Emanuel Church of the Evangelical Association – In 1866 funds were collected and a lot presented to the association by Theodore and Margaret D. Fenn. The corner stone of the building was laid June 24, 1866 and it was dedicated December 23, 1866. The church was rebuilt in

The Lutheran Church – The Lutheran Church was first serviced by Rev. J. Harpster during the year 1870. The church, a beautiful brick building, was rebuilt in 1901.





The Methodist Episcopal Church was organized by 15 members in the year 1872 by Rev. Graham. During 1873 the congregation built a church at a cost of \$2400. The building was thirty-five by fifty feet.



CHURCH OF GOD

The Church of God .- The first meetings of this denomination in Marysville were held in 1850. Occasional services were conducted until 1866 in a Union Church, when an organization was effected. In 1869 the congregation erected a fine frame house, forty by fifty feet, at a cost of twenty-five hundred dollars. David Stahler, A. M. Brady, M. A. Brady, Joseph Gensinger, Susan Gensinger, David Cowen and Elizabeth Cowen were among the original members of the congre-

The following-named ministers served the congregation: A. Snyder, T. Still, S. V. Sterner, C. L. Amy, J. C. Owens, G. W. Getz, S. S. Richmond, G. W. Coulter, J. A. Mc-Dannel, C. Koler. Rev. S. C. Stonesifer is the pastor at the present time.


