- 1. Sewer Separation Project, Bidding for Project (January)**

Dave asked once the project is over that the Easements for the combined sewer main that runs through the private properties be changed to give eliminate the easement on their deeds.  
Scott stated that he has sent communications to Mr. Kocher about the pump station at the corner of Verbeke and Lansvale Streets. Mr. Kocher is working with us to come to an agreement.
- 2. MS4 Permitting (Application 9/15/17) Met with Lions Club, No Response.**
- 3. Purchase of Sweeper**

After much discussion the committee agreed to wait to the spring (March/April) to look for a used sweeper.
- 4. Repair Sweeper from SEI \$13,255.00**

The committee agreed not to move forward with any repairs.
- 5. Control Systems 21 (Nanodac Flow Recorder \$2,345.65) Emergency Repair.**

Scott informed the committee the details behind having to purchase the flow recorder. Also Scott inform the committee that there is a three year pay back due to not have to purchase charts, pens, and manually having to input the information for the DEP report.

**6. Belt Filter Press New Belts \$2,171.69 (old one has a tear)**

Scott informed the committee that we had to move forward with the purchase of the new belts due to a tear in one of the belts. Dave asked if we save the good one to use if needed. Scott said yes that we would save the good side use it in case of an emergency.
