The projects were reviewed and no changes were recommended so they will be sent to the council for final approval.

John Fasnacht gave a list of concerns he had at Heritage Park and the committee decided to have the road crew go and fix up some of the maintenance issues such as signs and keeping the bank trimmed. Some of the other issues could be addressed by getting some grant money to help spruce up the park.
