New Business

Shed for the Pool

Rich would like to have a shed purchased for the pool. Rich said currently we have chemicals stored in the guard shack and it's a safety issue. The shed will be used for storage of chemicals, lawn mower, weed whacker and tools needed for the pool. The 10x12 shed would cost \$3,736.00 plus the cost of stone. The committee agreed to put the purchase of the shed on the council agenda for approval. Charles asked Zach to have a total cost for the shed and materials for the meeting.

New Pump

Rich said the new pump was installed at the pool and needs to have power run to it. He said he talked to X10 Electric and they recommend replacing the old lines and installing a new panel box. The cost would be around \$1,600.00. The committee agreed to put this on the council agenda.

Robotic Pool Cleaner
