## **New Business**

### **Christmas Tree Lighting**

The committee agreed to coordinate the tree lighting with the library's visit with Santa. The committee agreed to purchase the refreshments. The committee wants the maintenance guys to straighten the tree.

## **Old Business**

### **Brew and Wine Grass Fest 2020 – Beer and Wine Garden**

This was tabled until William has met with LCB and Ronda can attend the next meeting for further discussion.

The committee met with William from the Marysville Moose Lodge. William said the lodge is interested in having the event jointly. Below are some of the items that we discussed:
