New Business

1. Chlorine Tank Regulator Replacement

A crack was discovered in one of the Chlorine Tank Regulators. Staff would like to buy a new regulator and send out the broken one to be fixed so it can be used as a spare. The Committee was agreed and it was referred to the Finance Committee.

A Tank alarm keeps going off at the plant. Staff had a technician come to look the issue and it was determined that the console was bad and that a new console was needed the committee agreed and it was referred to the Finance Committee.
