Long Term Planning:

The Valve replacement and mixer replacement is being placed into the 2021 budget for consideration by council.

New Business

The Committee wanted to add MS4 to the agenda for future meetings. The Borough Manager and Borough Engineer were going to discuss projects for 2021.

Old Business

1. Tapping Fee Increase

Greg presented the initial study for increasing the tapping fee that the borough charges residents to connect to the sewer system.

2. Flow from the trailer park

Pete reported that the trailer park did find a water leak and repaired that leak and that reduced their flow by about 10,000 gallons. The next step will be to place another flow meter in the manhole to get a more accurate reading of how much infiltration and inflow is getting into the sewer system.

3. North Main Sewer Main Project Update

Able was on site finishing up the last parts of the lining. The last step before the project is complete is for them to video tape the whole line for the boroughs records.
