New Business

1. Grass replanting

After the sewer separation project, new grass was planted and does not seem to be holding up very well. The committee suggested borough staff put down new topsoil and replant new grass.

2. SBR 2 guide rail system

The Committee was given an update on the broken guide rail system that holds the pump in place. A submersible sump pump was borrowed from another sewer treatment plant is being run now until a permanent fix can be put in place.

3. Junk Scrappers

Lance brought up the idea of looking into an ordinance on how to regulate Junk Scrappers who are picking scrap and bring it to their house to sit.

Old Business

1. Tapping Fee Increase

Greg reported they are still doing the research on the fee increase but they were running into problems because not a lot of data exist but he still believes the borough will be able to raise the fee if they choose.

2. Flow from the trailer park

The flow meter was borrowed from PA Rural Water was returned to have them analyze the data. Once the data is returned the borough can discuss next steps.

3. North Main Sewer Main Project Update

The project is mostly complete there is still one small area that ABLE needs to come in and repair.
