**Old Business**

Upgrades at Pump Station #2

Pennoni went over the information for the generator. The committee asked Lonnie to get quotes on the new generator and explore more options on a service contract. They suggested checking with the group installing the generator and X10 Electric.

Sewer Main along River (river too high to do anything)

Lonnie said he spoke to Ken and they agreed a trench box is a little leery for them to dig. Lonnie said the employees will not be able to do it themselves. Lonnie said there is a lot of tree roots and debris. The estimated cost would be around \$150.00 per foot to have the sewer main cleaned out. The committee asked Lonnie and Pete to get the total footage. The committee agreed to place this item on the finance committee agenda.

Lower Hydraulic Loading (engineer study)

Greg with Pennoni asked Lonnie if he had any comments regarding the engineer study? Lonnie said everything looked fine and he had no comments. Greg said he'll submit the study.

Maintenance Repair to Plant Generator

Pete went over the repairs that are needed to repair the generator. He said he is waiting on a quote from Cleveland Brothers.

### Advanced GeoServices

Robert May of Advanced GeoServices spoke to the committee regarding the underground storage tanks. He said testing will need to be done on the underground storage tank (please see file for compliance information). The spill tank will need to be tested by December 2019. The committee agreed to look into this further to see what action needs to be taken.

The committee agreed to have Lonnie talk to Keystone, who currently maintains the tank and see what actually will need to be done.

### **New Business**

#### Line Locator

Pete presented the committee with information and a price of \$1,554.95 for a line locator. He said this would help in locating sewer lines. The committee agreed to place this on the finance committee agenda.

### **Other Business**

#### Sidewalks on Lansvale Street

Greg said there our two addresses on Lansvale Street (511 & 601) that needs their sidewalk repaired from the sewer separation project. Greg said he talked to Ken and he said they could take care of. It would only be around \$200.00. The committee agreed to have the borough repair the sidewalks
