1. Sewer Separation Project, Anticipated Construction Schedule

Scott informed the committee that the 48" pipe is going in from Lansvale Street north along Bitting Avenue and the turning west and going to the fire house parking lot to make a connection. After the connection the crew will be working on Lincoln Street to complete the storm inlets and piping. Greg Rogalski borough engineer gave the committee a break down on the overall expenses and where we are at with the project. Overall we are in good shape and the only high expense is the paving that was added.

2. Sewer Main along River

Scott, Lonnie and Pete informed the committee that we have a root ball in the main trunk line and that we will be working to remove this as soon as the river low enough to start the work. Scott sent the home owner a letter asking to remove the tree. If the tree is in our way we will have to remove it ourselves to complete the pipe replacement.

3. Chlorine Scale (\$1,700)

The committee approved to place this line item on the council agenda.

4. DEP Inspection

Scott, Lonnie, and Pete informed the committee about the inspection and how long and challenging it was since this was the inspector's first inspection and his boss was along for the inspection. No results back from the inspection yet, but we believe the inspection went well.
