#### 1. Park & Ridgeview Drive (Punch List/Standing Water)

The punch list was completed in March. The committee and workers are still concerned about the standing water in one area. This is mostly due to a sump pump from a resident on Park Drive. We will continue to monitor this and possibly install a drain.

## 2. Paving of Streets (bid opening April 5<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 AM)

The committee has agreed to place an addendum on the bid to add fiber to some of the work that is being bid on at this time. Also to look at the paving project that is already bid to possibly put the fiber in the blacktop for Kings Highway as a good test road. More information for the council meeting is to be delivered at that meeting.

# 3. Bridge Inspection South Main over Fishing Creek (Steve and Scott to attend HATS April 12<sup>th</sup>)

We are staying on top of this issue so we are ready when the state is ready to move forward.

4. Dave Magee is concerned about the pavement cracking on Cameron Street and he believes it's from the heavy trucks running on that road during the sewer separation project. Bill Rudy and Scott will look at the pre-construction video to see if they captured that street and if so to check on the roads condition.
