1. Paving of Streets (Suez water main 2020)

Scott started off with introducing John Miller from Suez and how Suez plans for water main replacement will alter our plans for paving a couple streets. After some discussion from all it was determined that we would still repair Front and Overcrest intersection and just use base for the repair and then after the pipe replacement Suez will mill and place the wearing course in that intersection. Suez will also take care of Leonard Street for the wearing course as well. Dave asked about the cracking of Cameron Street and if Greg and Scott had a chance to look at this. Scott stated that Suez proposed water main construction will go right through that area and that they would have to replace the blacktop and that would take care of the cracks.

2. Bridge Inspection South Main over Fishing Creek

Scott and Steve attended the HATS meeting in April and were able to make good contacts with the personnel and get our bridge replacement on the table once again.

3. Linden Avenue Road Repair

The committee and others asked many questions about the amount of damage due to a water main break and what are Suez and the borough doing for the residents. John Miller from Suez was in attendance and got blasted with question and concerns that he will take back to their office for discussion.
