# 1. Street Sweeper and Demo

He was asking to possibly revisit this after the streets project is complete. He also asked if there are any signs we can put up to slow the traffic. The committee asked Scott to see if we have any Children at Play signs and if so get those installed. Scott stated that he will be getting the speed devise from Penn Township in the near future to place on Ridgeview Drive.
