Old Business

Road Project

Kim said Ken is working on getting quotes for the big dump truck. Lance suggested purchasing a leaf attachment and box to fit one of the other smaller trucks. Steve suggested looking into getting a forward dumping salt bin. Rob said it takes roughly a year to build a new truck. Lance suggested hauling our own sludge. We should look into the cost of dumping and how many times a week it would need dumped. Dave said if we haul our own sludge a portion of the truck can be purchased out of the Sewer Fund.
