New Business

1. Speed Limit North Main Street

The committee discussed the process of changing the speed limit which did include a traffic study. The committee discussed the difficulty of enforcing the speed limit on North Main Street. It was suggested that the new speed sign that the police department has should be placed on North Main Street for two weeks. Bill Rudy then mentioned that the data that is collected from the speed sign could be used instead of a traffic study. The committee directed the borough manager to talk to Chief Richards to inquiry about moving the sign.

2. Parking on Laurel

The committee decided at there would not be enough room on the street to allow parking on Laurel. Mr. Border will contact the requestor to let her know.

3. John Carroll 119 Ridgeview Fence Issue

Mr. Carroll came to the meeting to discuss an issue he is having with his neighbor and a fence that was erected. He also wanted to discuss the backyard and how much of a mess it was. The committee discussed the fence and told Mr. Carroll that under the current ordnance the fence was allowed but, that the borough manager would go over and investigate the issues in the back yard.

4. Fence Hight around Basin's Rockville Estate Phase 1

The Committee decided it was okay for the four-foot fence to be installed.

Old Business

1. Road Project – Jay Fulkroad and Sons

The Borough Solicitor is still working to resolve the issues with the contractor.

2. Bridge Inspection South Main over Fishing Creek/Grant Application

The application for Regional Transport Plan Grant was submitted July 30. The latest bridge inspection report was included with the application.

3. Sink Hole Kings Highway

The committee decided to use a contractor to perform the work. The borough engineer recommends using Rogele. Zach will find out the rate schedule present this to council.
