Trucks/Equipment:

Ken would like to change this item from re-chassis to purchasing a new truck that will make all of the trucks up to date and then the borough can start to re-chassis the trucks moving forward.

New Business

1. Davey's BBQ request

There was a request from Davey's BBQ to put up a tent on borough property the committee felt this should not be allowed because it would then open it up for anyone who wanted to put a tent on borough property the right to do that.

2. New Tires

Staff wanted to replace the tires on the 2019 since they are factory tires and did not have good tread the cost would be around 1900 dollars. Ken did say they would pass inspection but all other trucks have had the tires changed from the factory ties to goodyears. This was recommended to the finance committee

3. Liquid Brine Attachment

Staff would like to be able to pretreat the roads with a liquid brine which is a mixture of salt and water the brine itself can be purchased from Lower Allen township for around 21 cents a gallon the tank to store it in would be 500 and the spreader would be around 5000. The belief is this would save money on staff and salt cost. This was recommended to the finance committee.

The Statements of interest were due today the next step is for the committee to review the submissions and rank the top 3 and then council would select the engineer to move forward.
