#### New Business

## 1. Review of the October Minutes

The minutes were reviewed by the committee and no changes were made.

# 2. Rockville Pump Station

There were 5 homes that closed in Phase 3, but the pump station was not delivered the so the developer come up with the idea to have the wet well pumped every other day and then take the waste and dump into a manhole so that it could run to the plant. An overflow alarm was also required to be put in and a berm was built around in case of an overflow. The committee was okay with the plan, but wanted to have extra pump outs around the holidays and wanted to revisit the progress of the pump station in January and all agreed to those conditions.

# 3. Manhole in Fishing Creek

There was a spill in Fishing Creek of sewage. After the cleanup, Lonnie and Pete noticed a hole in the manhole which allowed the sewerage to come out. They did patch the hole, but it may not be a permanent fix so the engineer was going to take a look and come back with suggestions.
