

## Streets Sewer and Sanitation Meeting Minutes June 6, 2022 2:15 PM

The Streets, Sewer and Sanitation Committee meeting was called to order at 2:15 PM on Monday, June 5, 2022 at the Marysville Borough Office. Present were Committee Members Lance Barthel, John Edkin and Jackie Zulli, Committee Chair. Also present were Maintenance Workers, Ken Miller and Rob Laman; Sewer Operators, Lonnie Sarver and Pete Boele; Borough Engineer, Greg Rogalski and Borough Manager, Zachary Border

#### <u>New Business</u>

### 1. <u>Review Minutes from the Previous Meeting</u>

The minutes were reviewed and no corrections were needed.

### 2. Kings Highway

This is follow-up to an issue a resident had with stormwater damaging their property which was already addressed, but Zach had asked Greg to look at the road to make sure there was no other damage and Greg reported that all was good with the road.

### 3. Paving List

Greg and Zach took a drive around town to look at roads that still need to be paved and Greg presented a list to the Committee for consideration and funding in the 2023 Budget. This was reviewed and sent to the Finance Committee for discussion in order to see what could be added to next year's budget.

### 4. Sewer Billing

A discussion was held on changing from a flat rate billing to water consumption billing. The Committee decided to tablet his item in order for staff to do more research.

# 5. Low-Income Household Water Assistance Program

Zach was contacted by the Perry County Assistance Office regarding a resident who contacted them about help with a sewer bill. Zach was told the state offers a program to help residents who are behind in sewer and water. Zach explained the program to the Committee who then recommended it be placed on the Council Workshop Agenda.

# 6. <u>Picture Perfect Perry County</u>

Zach announced to the Committee that, as part of the County Comp Plan, they were looking for projects from the municipalities to add to the Comp Plan. The Committee came up with a few ideas such as improving Heritage Park, improving parking throughout the Borough and upgrades to the Sewer Plant to prevent future flooding. Zach will fill out the Picture Perry Form and send them to Jason at the County Planning Office.

### 7. CDBG Funding

Zach announced that he is applying for CDBG money from the County and was asking the Committee for projects that he could apply for. The Committee came up with upgrading the heating system at the treatment plant, replacing the sewer main on North Main Street, upgrading Pump Station 3 to help resolve the issue of overflowing. These Ideas were sent to Council for more discussion.
